



School Uniform Policy

January 2026

1. Purpose

Our school uniform policy supports equality, safety, and a positive learning environment. It follows UK Government guidance by ensuring uniform requirements are **affordable, practical, and inclusive**, while allowing parents and carers flexibility in where items are purchased.

2. Main School Uniform

All pupils are expected to wear the following during the school day:

- **Black sweatshirt** (with or without school logo)
- **White polo shirt**
- **Black trousers or black joggers**
- **Skirts with tights or leggings under**

The following items are **not permitted**:

- Leggings
- Jeans
- Brightly coloured or patterned clothing
- Crocs
- Shoes without backs.

3. Footwear

- **Dark-coloured shoes**, which may include **trainers**
- Shoes should be suitable for school activities and safe for playground use
- Open-toed shoes, sandals, or footwear with heels are not permitted

4. Physical Education (PE) Uniform

Pupils should wear suitable clothing for PE activities:

- **Plain T-shirt** (no large logos or slogans)
- **Jogging trousers** or sports bottoms suitable for physical activity

A **specific school PE uniform** is available to purchase but is **not compulsory**.

5. Branded Items

- A **black sweatshirt with the school logo** and the **official PE uniform** may be purchased from **Tots to Teams**. Website -- totstoteams.com
- Branded items are optional, in line with government guidance, and non-branded alternatives are fully acceptable

6. Equality and Inclusion

We are committed to ensuring this policy does not discriminate against any pupil on the basis of gender, religion, disability, or family circumstances. Reasonable adjustments will be made where required.

7. Support with Uniform

Families experiencing difficulty in providing uniform are encouraged to contact the school in confidence. Support may be available.
