Personal Response

You will produce a final piece which shows your own understanding of the theme

You are taught how to use dark and light materials to show different values



Collage & Photography

Learn how to combine collage techniques with other media such as paint and drawing materials



You will experiment with collagraph printmaking techniques

You will learn papier-mâché techniques including how to build up layers to create a range of textured surfaces

Printmaking

Taught how to produce a detailed block which includes a range of raised surface textures

Sculpture

You will use recycled materials to build a relief sculpture.

You will be taught how to produce annotated designs for a sculpture

You will learn about the differences between acrylic and watercolour paint



You will produce watercolour paintings using the different techniques learned

You will revisit drawing from observation and practice applying tone using pencil, pastels and charcoal.




Painting

You will be taught a range of watercolour techniques including masking, wet on wet, wet on dry, lifting and graded wash.

You will learn how to produce accurate line drawings which are to scale using the grid method.



Teachers notes..... The theme **Man-made** is explored throughout Year 9. Students learn how to use a sketchbook to record their **ideas, developing and refining their work as it progresses**. They **record** and **research** the life and work of different artists linked to the theme. They reflect upon their work, and consider what they have achieved. **Students also use notes and annotation to support visual work.**
